You do not have to endure assault or battery in silence. If you are verbally threatened or physically assaulted, file a police report and contact OEA. It has been reported in the past that some teachers were talked out of filing charges by police officers. That may only be a rumor, but do not hesitate to file the charges and let OEA know directly or through your Association Representative. In addition, insist that site administrators take action immediately. If your concern is ignored by administration, contact your Building Representative.

If you have to file a charge, make sure you get the officer's name and a case number. Immediately sit down and write out a description of what happened. Be very factual. Give times, names of assailant(s), witnesses, locations and the exact words said, including any profanity.
